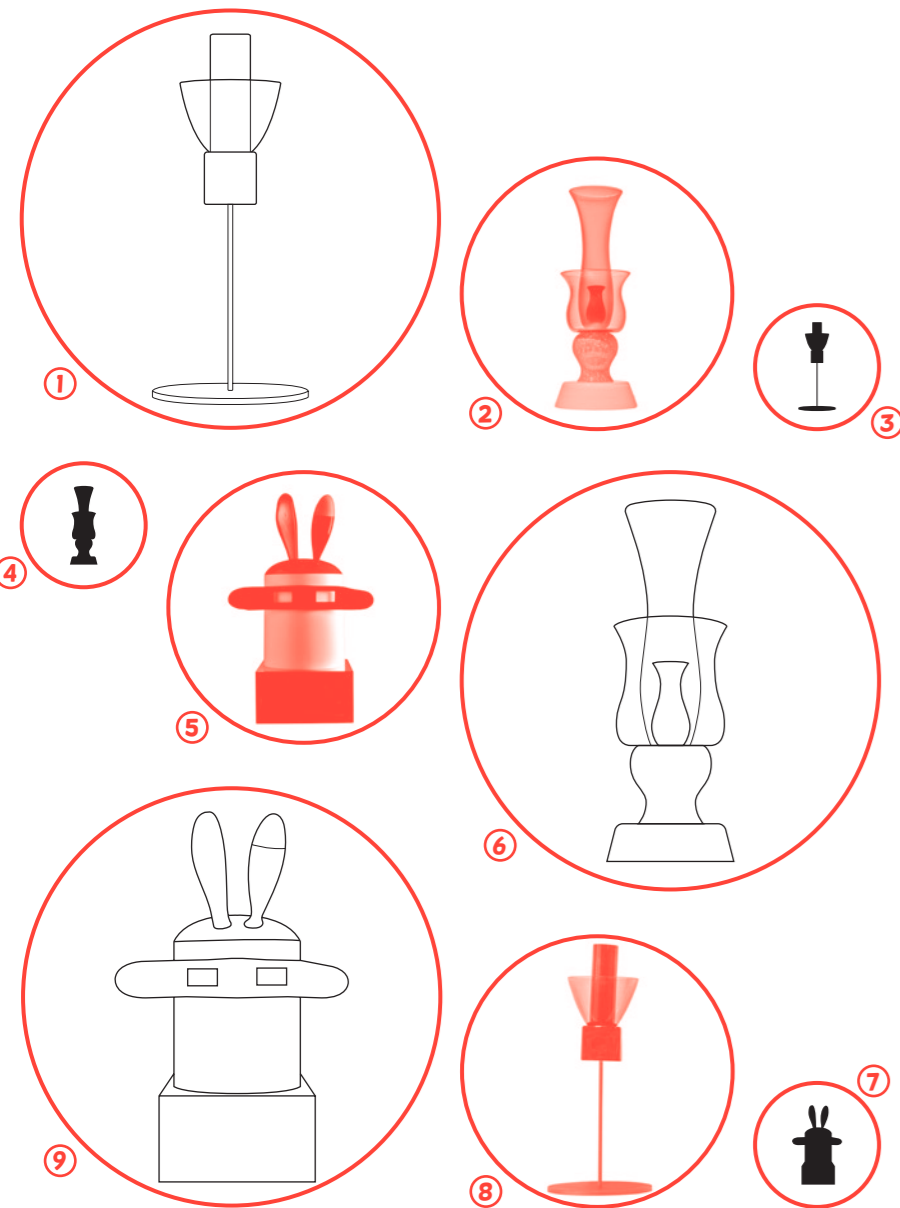

THREE IN A ROW!

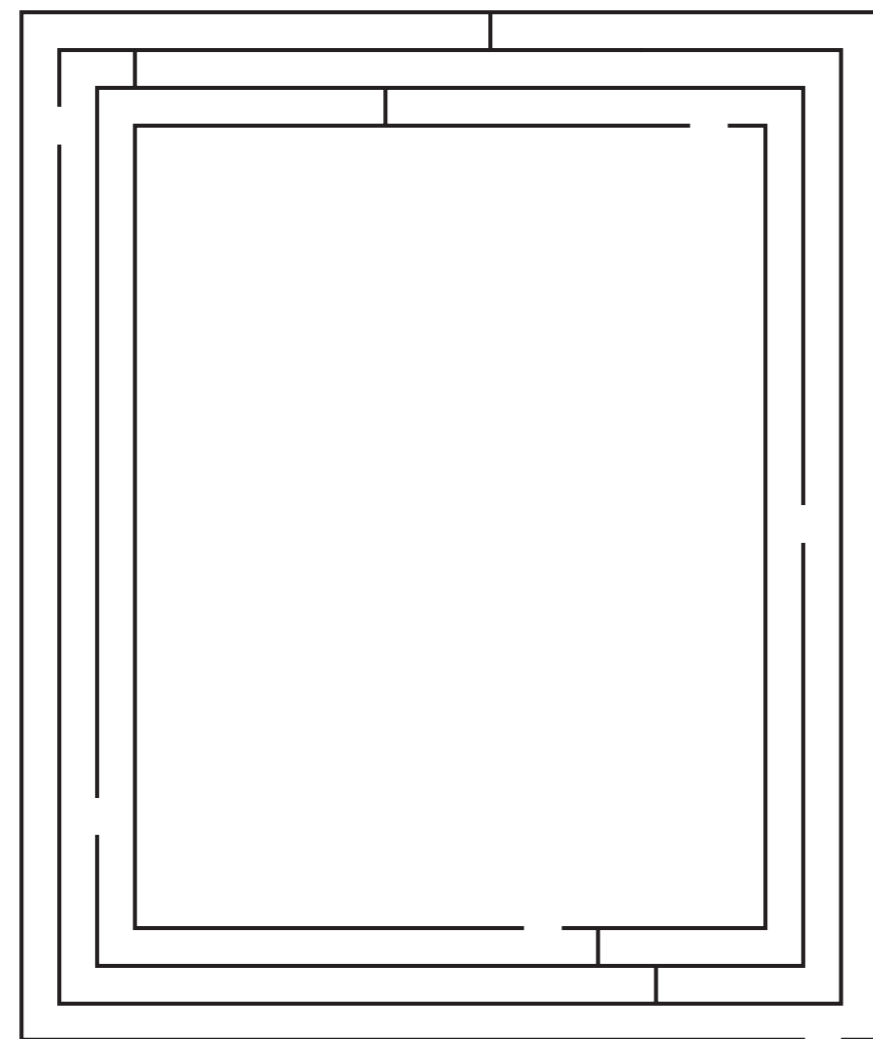
For each vase shape connect the black image with the red and white image. Then colour them in to match the glass objects that you saw in the exhibition.

Draw your favorite Kachina in the center, guide it out of the labyrinth and write your name!



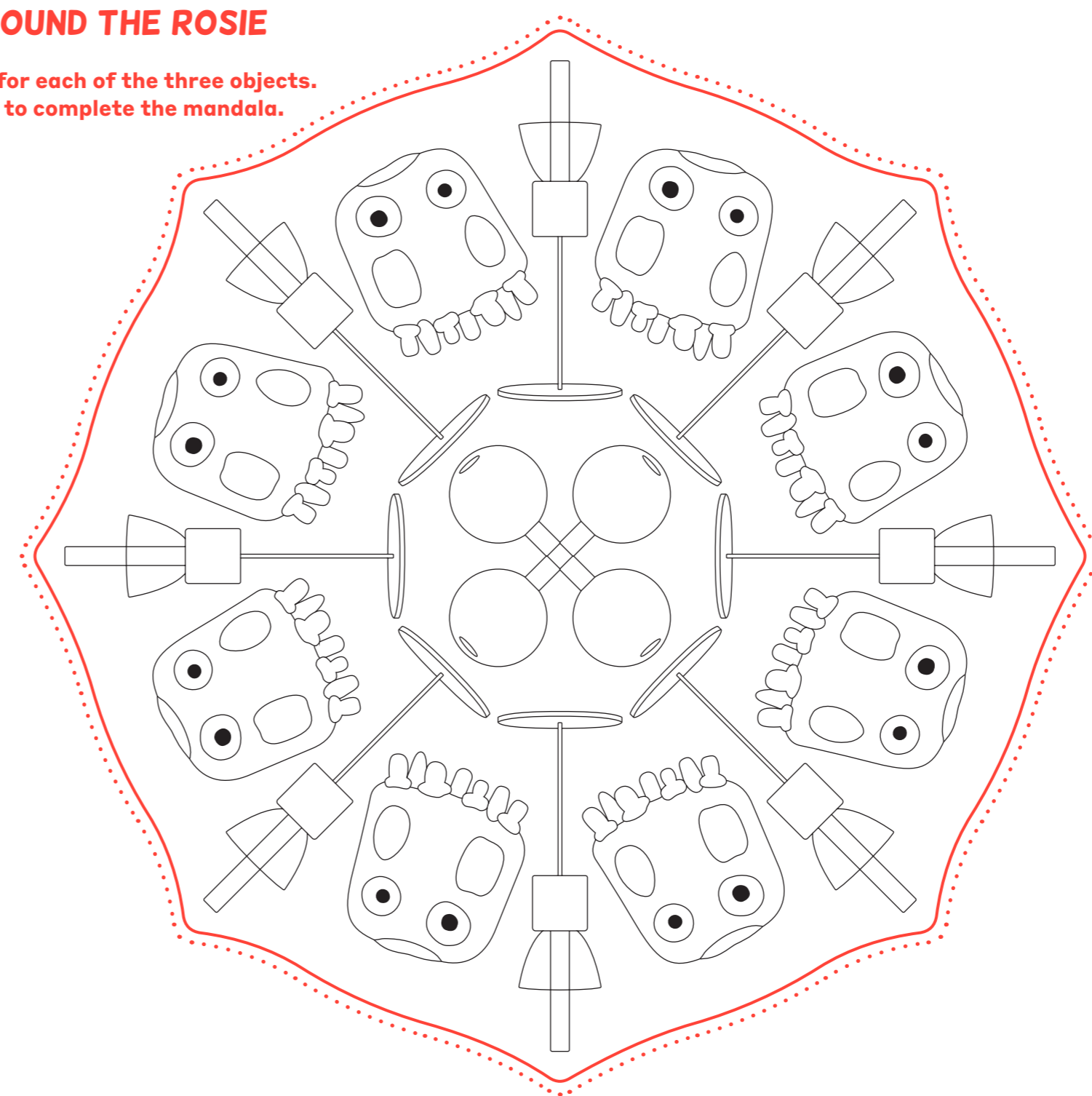
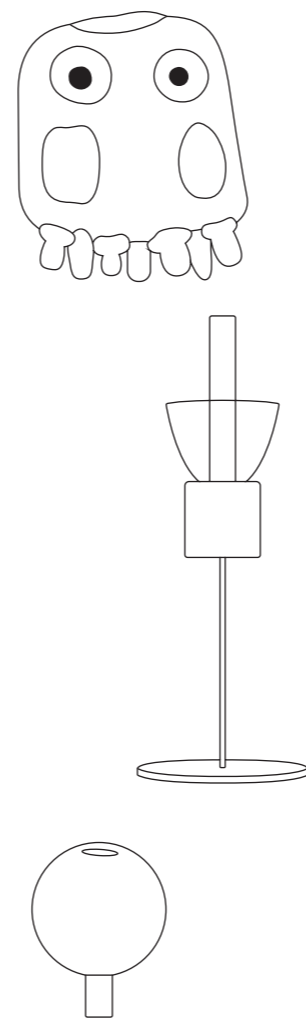

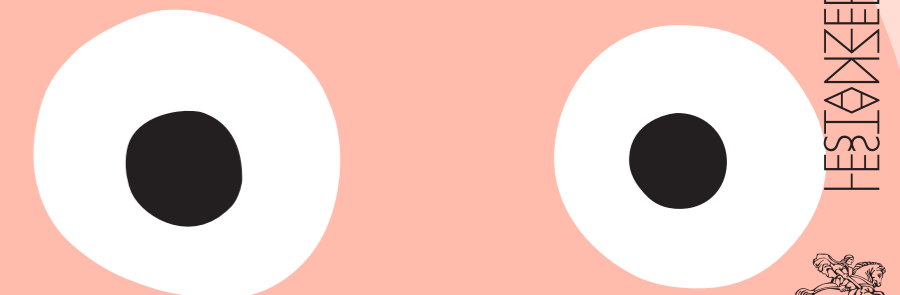
MAGIC RING AROUND THE ROSIE

My name is **ETTORE SOTTASS**,

During my life I loved to draw,
paint, travel and meet
new people.

**I WAS AN ARCHITECT LIKE
MY DAD.** I not only designed
houses and shops around
the entire world but also vases,
mirrors, clocks, furniture
and office machines.

**I WAS INTERESTED IN COLOURS AND
MATERIALS AND LOVED TO MIX THEM ALL UP!**
Marble, glass, ceramic and metal all go
well with each other, both in their own
natural colour and in the colour that
I chose for them...

WHAT DO YOU LIKE ABOUT GLASS?

I like the fact that glass **ALLOWS ME
TO PLAY WITH LIGHT** as if it were another
fun material!

Glass can be **BOTH TRANSPARENT AND COLOURED**
at the same time – it can come in many different
see-through or **OPAQUE COLOURS**. So by placing
pieces of glass of different colour, shape
and transparency next to each other I can obtain
endless **compositions** and shades.

ARE YOU CHEEKY?

... I HAVE BEEN - WITH GLASS!
These glass creations, called "Caprices", are a bit "cheeky"
because look at how they are **HANGING**, suspended in the air
like they are about to move at any moment.

LET'S HOPE THE GLUE HOLDS

Look at that nice **yellow balloon** at the center.
Its name in this Oriental language means egg...
let's hope it doesn't fall off!

HAVE YOU EVER VISITED FAR-AWAY COUNTRIES?

I have been to the United States
of America and many times to Asia.
In New York I met an architect friend
who collected old American Indian
dolls called "KACHINA"!

For the Native American Indians they
represented **FRIENDLY SPIRITS**, for me they are
like friends who watch over me.
